

# Plush Puppy TN Grooming Products

Here are some hints & tips I have found to help you get the best results from your Plush Puppy products. [Click on each heading to visit this product on our website.](#)

**Reviva Coat** - This is basically what I refer to as moisturizer in a can. It will condition the coat but unlike conditioner it does not soften or flatten the coat but what it does is moisturize it. It can be used a couple of ways. It comes in the form of a mousse. You can apply the foam directly to the coat. This is especially good in areas that are really dry or tangle easily. The other way to use it is to break it down with water. I normally say about a 1/3 foam into 2/3 of water. Use this as a grooming spray to help you comb through the coat. It will make it a lot easier and at the same time moisturize it. It also smells fantastic. We use it every day on the dogs we are showing and you cannot use too much of this product. I have some people that like to use it for wrapping as well. It helps cut down on coat breakage too. It is great for areas like top knots etc by scrunching the Reviva coat into this area it helps to back the moisture.

**Blow Dry Cream** - This product basically flattens and softens a coat. You mix it up about 1 tablespoon to 1 cup of water. Spray it into the coat and blow dry. This is great if you have a fuller coat and want to flatten it down. It can be mixed with the swishy coat.

**Swishy Coat** - This product is fantastic. This will help you with Static, flyaway and help to straighten wave. Every coat is different so some coats may only need half a tablespoon to a cup of water. For Maltese, Yorkies, I suggest a table spoon to a gallon of water and for Afghans, Cockers etc a tablespoon to a cup. That is one extreme to the other. This is a very light product and when applied you cannot even feel it in the coat.

**Volumising Cream** - This is if you need more coat or a fuller coat. About a tablespoon to 1 cup of water. Spray it through the coat and blow dry. This is great if you have a dog that does not have enough coat and you want to make it feel and look fuller. One tip when mixing this product is to only half fill the bottle that you are mixing it in as it does expand a little. Then top it off with the rest of your water. Also when mixing if you use warm water it will dissolve quicker. Make sure that when you mix any products, that your container you are using is only half full, as this will help it mix much quicker.

**Sit N Stay** - This product has a variety of uses. It is a sculpting product. Originally used for terriers etc. for eyebrows, making furnishings stand off etc. It can be used for helping to build bone or as a pre-chalker. In breeds such as the Havanese it is used to hold the bangs back. The secret to using this product is to apply it to the base of the hair so you make the shaft stand up. Once it is dry you can comb it through.

**Protein Coat Balm** - This is an anti-static, anti flyaway product. To apply simply put a couple of pumps into your hand and smear them together. Then drag the coat/furnishings through your hands coating it with protein coat balm. Great to stop those flyaway hairs.

**Odour Muncher** - This is totally safe to spray directly onto the dog or in your RV, house, car etc. You only need a couple of pumps. It will leave a pleasant fragrance.

**Ruffy Tuffy** - Apply in layers. Spray it onto the coat and then dry. If you use a dryer it will dry a lot quicker but you can let it dry naturally (takes about 10 minutes). When it is dry feel the texture and if you want more apply another layer. You will not feel the difference in the coat until it is dry.

**Pixie Dust** - This powder has a shimmer to it. It can add lift and depth to a dull coat and also add that extra shimmer to a healthy coat. I like to mix a tablespoon in with my chalk to give it a little brighter look. To apply it to a dog you sprinkle a very small amount onto a brush and then tap the brush over the dog letting the dust fall over the dog then brush through the coat. ONLY use a small amount.

**Shine and Comb** is a finishing spray that is purely cosmetic. It will leave a wonderful shine on the coat and help to richen up colors. For the best effect I suggest that you hold the bottle about 1 to 1 ½ foot from the dog and mist it over the coat. You only need a small amount. With longer coated breeds it is best to spray it over the top of the dog and then use the Protein Coat balm down the sides if you intend to brush the coat. The difference with the protein coat balm is that it is a lighter product and you will not get static when brushing it.

**Sea Breeze Oil** is lovely fine oil. It is water-soluble. I like to mix about 5 pumps or 1 tablespoon of oil to about a gallon of water and then pour it over the coat and not rinse out. The coat feels healthy and it helps to give a lovely shine and also intensify color. It is also great to help with dandruff, which comes after bathing. It can be sprayed directly onto the coat for wrapping purposes or if you have a coat that is quite badly damaged. Also great for removing tree sap and tape residue.

**Cover Up Cream** - This is another product that is done in layers. Use a washcloth or sponge and rub it into the coat. Once it has dried you can reapply a second layer. If you have a heavily stained area you can do a third layer and then I chalk over that. I also find that using the PP Pixie Dust to chalk over the top gives a better coverage and really makes it look whiter (just my opinion). This product is water soluble so remember this if you are using it for tearstains etc.

**Quick Fix Conditioner** - This product has a hold factor. You can mist the coat with it and blow dry or brush up. Another way is to spray it on your brush and brush it through the coat or into your hands and scrunch it through the coat. Get it down to the base where possible. This product dries fairly quickly. In the event that you do use too much and the coat feels sticky then a misting of PP Shine & Comb will take that sticky feeling away.

For all shampoos, I dilute them down 7 pumps to a 16oz bottle of water. I have some people that tell me they dilute it down even more. You will find that the shampoos rinse out very quickly.

**Natural Conditioning Shampoo** is great for long flowing coats and also for softening coats. When I use the shampoo I normally dilute it in a 16oz bottle of water that I fill about 2/3 with water and put about 5 or 6 pumps of shampoo. I have had people tell me they dilute it as much as 3 pumps to a 16oz bottle. It will help to re-hydrate the coat and give it a silky soft feel.

**Natural Body Building Shampoo** - This shampoo gives a little more body to the coat and also will give a little texture. I use this when my dogs are out of coat just to give it a little more body and also to help it stand off.

**Herbal Whitening Shampoo** is great on black, grey and white coats. It does not stain the coat and I suggest the dilution rate of that as about the same as the other shampoos. The only thing about using a whitening shampoo is that you should not use it on a tan/red/brown coat. It will actually help to fade the coloring. This is good though if you have some sun burning that you want to try to fade out. Of course it is not going to work miracles if your coat is sun burnt totally red but will help with red tipping. I like to apply the shampoo and leave it sits for about 3-5 minutes then wash it out. On the feet I normally just put a pump into my hands and rub it in for any bad staining such as urine, red clay etc.

**Natural All Purpose Shampoo** - Great for short coated breeds as it leaves a nice shine on the coat and will not change the texture of the coat. We also use this on all our red coated dogs, as it seems to really bring out the red in the coat.

**Silk Protein Conditioner** is also fantastic. It is a very light conditioner that does not leave the coat feeling oily or greasy. If I have a really full coat that is very fluffy and airy I also suggest that a couple of pumps of the conditioner be put in with the swishy coat mixture and leave it in. I have groomed a couple of powder puff crested and their coat is so light and sometimes the conditioner just helps to lay it down a little.
